GPA in program required courses	8	GPA of all program-required courses, multiplied by 2

Previous degrees	3	<i>Master or Higher = 3 points</i> <i>Bachelor = 2 points</i> <i>Associate = 1 point</i>
Full-time load	1	<i>Full-time load = 1 point</i> <i>Completion of a 12 credit hour load semester in the previous two (2) years with a minimum 2.5 GPA in which at least one science or math pre-requisite was completed with a C or better.</i>

*In the event two candidates' admission scores are tied for a single position, preference will be given based on the following criteria:*

- 1) TEAS score*
- 2) If still tied after examining TEAS, then we will examine GPA*
- 3) If still tied after examining TEAS and GPA, the applicant who has successfully completed the most pre-requisite coursework at the time of application review will be offered the position.*
