

KANSAS CITY KANSAS COMMUNITY COLLEGE: PRACTICAL NURSING PROGRAM

PREREQUISITES: (The grade point average for Anatomy & Physiology (5-year deadline), Medical Terminology, Psychology, and Human Development must be 2.5 or higher.)

- BIOL-0143 - Anatomy & Physiology, 5 Credit Hours
(**Must be taken within 5 years** of the start date of the Practical Nursing program.)
- ALHT-0120- Medical Terminology 1 Credit Hour
- PSYC-0101- Psychology, 3 Credit Hours
(Psyc-0101 is the prerequisite for Human Growth and Development at KCKCC.)
- PSYC-0203 - Human Development, 3 Credit Hours
- Current/Active Kansas Certified Nurse Assistant (CNA) License – ALHT 0104 can be taken at KCKCC (5 Cr)
- American Heart Association CPR/BLS
- ATI TEAS test — a higher ATI TEAS score gives a competitive advantage; score must be 58 or above to be considered.
 1. Go to [ATI testing.com](http://ATItesting.com). Create an account (including setting a user name and password)
 2. Go to the on-line store. Register for the TEAS. Choose the state, city, and then school. Select the date on Which you would like to take the test. KS City KS CC PN — is the school institution that you want to apply for. Maximum of 3 attempts only to be considered for acceptance.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

Print both pages for the application and the check list then fill them out and bring to the nursing office room 3602. - All required documentation must be in the candidate's file by the predetermined application deadline. Incomplete files will not be considered. Seating is limited and the selection process is competitive. 20-40 students are selected from a pool of qualified applicants for admission to the class that starts every January and every August.
- **APPLICATION/CHECKLIST DEADLINES:** October 15th for January start class, April 15th for August start class.
- A determination made by a review committee process allows acceptance into the program.
- **** Acceptance email/letters will be made by 1 month after application deadline for each semester.**
