Performance Grant Information

- Performance Grant Recipients are selected for the award based upon an audition and/or an interview. Technician/Design please bring some form of documented previous experience if experience exists. Two letters of recommendation are also required for each recipient requests.
- 2. Grants range from \$108.00 to \$2250.00 per semester. Grants do not cover the cost of textbooks or extraordinary course fees (i.e. online or Music Department Application course fees).
- 3. Applicants must have, and maintain, an overall 2.5 average.
- 4. Applicant deadlines are flexible. Generally applicants must apply before the beginning of the semester, but exceptions can be made.
- 5. Applicants must submit a department performance grant application form.
- Students are required to enroll in certain theatre courses each semester and
 participate in some capacity in each Department and Drama club production.
 Those receiving full scholarships must be enrolled in at least 12 credit hours
 unless an exception can be justified.
- 7. Scholarship students must receive permission from the Theatre Coordinator, prior to accepting any outside theatre opportunity.
- 8. If a student cannot work on a run crew or are not cast, they will be expected to put in 32 hours of work time in the shop. This must all be with the approval of the Theatre Coordinator.

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- 10. The awards are renewable for up to six (6) semesters, if the recipient is in good standing.
- 11. Students are notified by email with an offer letter that will be accompanied by an acceptance letter. If you accept the offer, you must sign and return the letter to the Theatre Department Coordinator, via email or post. Until this is received, it is simply an offer.
