

Equity

Providing resources to help individuals achieve their highest state of health and other functioning. Equity is an ongoing process of assessing needs and creating conditions for optimal outcomes by members of all social groups.

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How do you define inclusion?

Inclusion

An environment that offers affirmation, celebration, and appreciation of all approaches, styles, perspectives, and experiences, thus allowing all individuals to bring in their whole selves and to demonstrate their strengths and capacity.

Multicultural Engagement

The active participation of individuals from various cultural backgrounds in different activities, programs, or initiatives. It emphasizes understanding, respecting, and valuing various cultures to foster a greater sense of belonging. This approach often involves creating opportunities for cross-cultural interactions and promoting cultural awareness.

Overcome – solutions, support, advocacy




