## FINANCIAL AID COURSE ELIGIBILITY EXCEPTION REQUEST

The U.S. Department of Education regulations require that a student must be enrolled in an eligible program of study to receive financial aid. In addition, only classes required for the student's program of study are eligible for financial aid funding. Classes not required for your program of study will not be eligible for any financial aid funding. There are some instances when a class is required but is not listed in your program of study. In those cases, the student must submit this form to indicate why an exception is necessary by filling out the information below. Before completing this form, please be aware that classes numbered below 0100 (MATH-0097, ENGL-0099, READ-0099, etc...) do not need an exception. These classes are considered "developmental" and are otherwise eligible for financial aid.

Exception requests will be reviewed by the Student Financial Aid Office. Complete and return this documentation to the KCKCC Student Financial Aid Office, the Technical Education Center, the Pioneer Career Center or email to finaid@kckcc.edu. If the information received results in a correction our office will notify you. Students will be notified through their student email regarding the results of their request.
