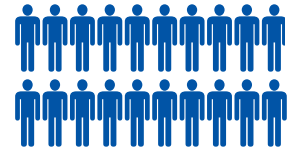
Impact of the increased earnings of KCKCC alumni and the businesses they work for

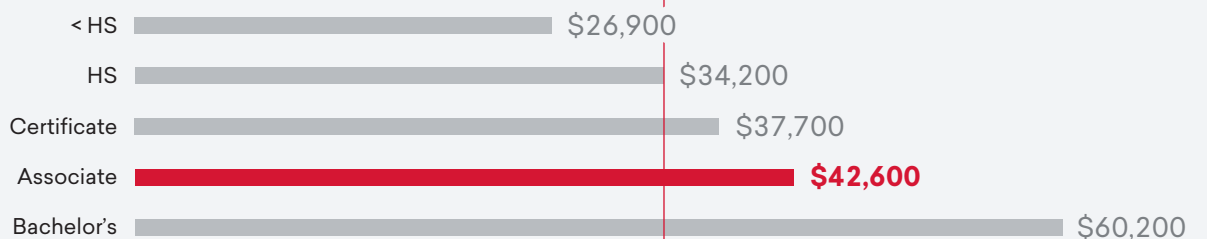

The average associate degree graduate from KCKCC will see an increase in earnings of **\$8,400** each year compared to someone with a high school diploma working in Kansas.

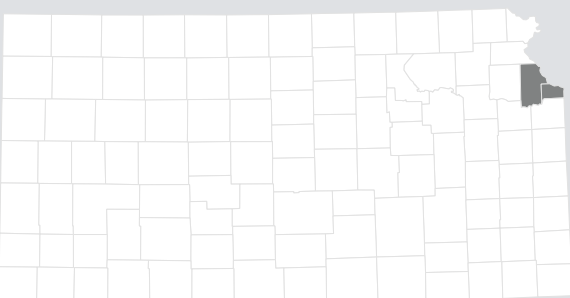
