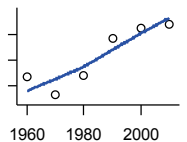

MEDIAN CONTRACT RENT (\$)

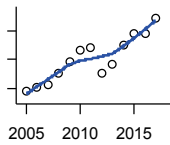

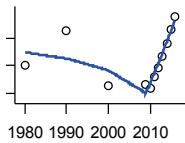

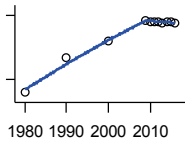

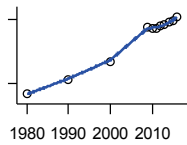


PERCENT HS GRADUATE OR HIGHER AGE 25+
