Column Definitions :

TECHNICAL SKILL ASSESSMENT PASS RATE (% AY 2017-18) : The percentage of CTE concentrators who passed technical skill assessments that are aligned with industry-recognized standards out of all CTE concentrators who attempted technical skill assessments during the reporting year. CTE concentrators are students who completed 12 or more credit hours in a Career and Technical program. The Technical Skill Assessment Pass Rate is from Perkins Core Indicator (1P1) Report generated by Kansas Board of Regent based on the Academic Year and Follow-Up data submitted by KCKCC for AY 2017-18.

CREDENTIAL, CERTIFICATE, OR DIPLOMA (% AY 2017-18): The percentage of CTE concentrators who received an industry-recognized credential, a certificate, or degree out of all CTE concentrators who left postsecondary education during the reporting year. The Credential, Certificate, or Diploma (%) is from Perkins Core Indicator (2P1) Report generated by Kansas Board of Regent based on the Academic Year and Follow-Up data submitted by KCKCC for AY 2017-18.

STUDENT RETENTION OR TRANSFER RATE (% AY 2017-18): The percentage of CTE concentrators who remained enrolled in their original postsecondary institution or transferred to another 2- or 4-year postsecondary institution during the reporting year and who were enrolled in postsecondary education in the fall of the previous reporting year. The denominator is the number of CTE concentrators who were enrolled in postsecondary education in the fall of the previous reporting year and who did not earn an industry-recognized credential, a certificate or a degree in the previous reporting year. Student Retention or Transfer Rate is from Perkins Core Indicator (3P1) Report generated by Kansas Board of Regent based on the Academic Year and Follow-Up data submitted by KCKCC for AY 2017-18.

STUDENT PLACEMENT (% AY 2017-18): The percentage of CTE concentrators who were placed or retained in employment, or placed in military service or apprenticeship programs in the 2nd quarter following the program year in which they left postsecondary education (i.e., unduplicated placement status for CTE concentrators who graduated by June 20, 2007 would be assessed between October 1, 2007 and December 31, 2007). The denominator is the number of CTE concentrators who left postsecondary education during the reporting year. Student Placement Rate (%) is from Perkins Core Indicator (4P1) Report generated by Kansas Board of Regent based on the Academic Year and Follow-Up data submitted by KCKCC for AY 2017-18.
