


Faculty Spotlight

KCKCC has recently entered into a partnership with the University of Kansas Health System to offer Support Services employees in the health system an opportunity to earn a GED while on the job.

For those who qualify, KU will pay all program fees and pay for

their time, up to eight hours per week for classes on the main campus. Students will be assigned a mentor who is a member of the health system leadership team. These mentors will work with students throughout the program, offering encouragement and support. Details are currently being shared with Support Services employees and their managers.
