WHAT TO BRING:

Bedroom

- ▶ Bedding, blankets, sheets (size depends on room assignment)
- ▶ Pillows & Pillowcases
- ▶ Laundry basket and detergent
- ▶ Clothes hangers

Bathroom

- Medications
- ➤ Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, comb)
- ► Towels & washcloths
- ▶ Toilet paper
- ▶ Bath rug

School & Work

- ▶ Backpack
- ► Pens, pencils, highlighter
- ▶ Notebooks
- Photo ID and Social Security card (required for on-campus employment)
- Current medical insurance card and immunization records
- ▶ Debit and/or credit cards

Electronics

- ▶ Cell phone
- Computer
- ➤ Surge protectors
- ► Charging cables

Kitchen (this is a shared space, please coordinate with your roommates)

- ▶ Drinking glasses
- ▶ Plates and Bowls
- Utensils Forks, knives, & spoons
- ▶ Kitchen knives
- ▶ Cutting board
- ► Cooking pots & pans
- ➤ Small kitchen appliances (as needed):
 - Toaster/Toaster oven
 - Blender
 - Hand mixer
 - Coffee maker
- ▶ Measuring cups & spoons
- Mixing Bowls
- ▶ Colander
- Aluminum foil, plastic wrap, parchment paper
- ► Food storage containers
- Can opener
- ▶ Paper towels
- Dishwashing soap and dish towels

Cleaning

- ► Trash bags
- ▶ Sponges
- ► Dust cloths
- ► Disinfectant spray
- Vacuum, Broom, and Mop
- Laundry, Bathroom, and Kitchen cleaners

Other

- ► Sewing kit
- ▶ Umbrella
- ▶ Room Decorations

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

- ► Additional Furniture (No furniture can be removed from the room)
- Additional Fridges or Microwaves
- ► Lava or Halogen Lamps
- ▶ Space heaters or air conditioners
- ► Candles, incense, and wax warmers
- ▶ Pets (Please see the handbook for exceptions for accommodations)
- ▶ Weapons or weapon parts
- ➤ Tobacco products (cigarettes, e-cigarettes, vaping, tobacco, etc.)
- Alcohol and alcohol containers, such as wine or shot glasses, flasks, etc.
- Illegal Drugs or drug paraphernalia
- Nails, Push Pins, Duct Tape (only painters tape should be used on walls. Wall damage will result in checkout charges)
