

**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
KANSAS CITY KANSAS COMMUNITY COLLEGE
AND
DEVRY UNIVERSITY**

The following formal articulation agreement has been entered into between DeVry University of Kansas City and Kansas City Kansas Community College (KCKCC). The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate acceptance, without loss of earned college credit, for graduates of KCKCC associate degree programs into the DeVry Bachelor of Science in Technical Management.

A maximum of 20 credit hours beyond completion of any KCKCC associate degree will be accepted towards the BSTM degree. Students who transfer to DeVry must earn at least 42 credit hours of the program's required course work at DeVry to graduate and a minimum of 42 hours must be taken in upper division coursework (300-400 level courses). Applicants must provide official transcripts showing completion of one of the following KCKCC associate degrees:

- Associate in Applied Science (AAS)
- Associate in Arts (AA)
- Associate in Science (AS)
- Associate in General Studies (AGS)

Once one of the above degrees is conferred by KCKCC, remaining degree requirements are specified in an individual plan of study developed with each student through the academic advising process at DeVry. In developing this plan of study, the areas of coursework completed as part of the qualifying prior associate degree are taken into account, and DeVry coursework is added to achieve the combined minimum requirement listed. Skills development coursework or required prerequisites may increase program length. Specific courses and options listed below comprise the DeVry portion of the Bachelor of Science Degree in Technical Management:

Students who have completed courses beyond their associate degree that are equivalent to DeVry courses may be eligible for an additional 20 transfer credits, thereby reducing the potential remaining credits to be completed to 42.

This agreement affirms the commitment between DeVry University of Kansas City and the Kansas City Kansas Community College originally negotiated for the fall semester of 1997. The curriculum of all programs has been reviewed and updated to reflect current degree plans at the respective institutions as of May 2003.

DeVry University and the Kansas City Kansas Community College have the right to make note of and refer to this agreement in any catalog, promotional, professional or informational publications or releases.

Terms of Agreement:

This agreement is made and entered into in the academic year 2003-2004 and remains in force unless changed in writing by mutual agreement of both parties. The agreement may be amended at any time with the approval of both parties and is subject to regular review to assure currency with the respective degree requirements. Should either party desire to discontinue this agreement, advance notification of two years will be required.
