

**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN PITTSBURG STATE UNIVERSITY AND  
KANSAS CITY KANSAS COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

This agreement (the "Agreement") is made this 17th day of February 2010 (the "Effective Date") by and between **Kansas City Kansas Community College** (the "Education Partner") and Pittsburg State University, an institution of higher education organized and existing under the laws of the State of Kansas ("PSU"):

WHEREAS, the parties intend to establish an Articulation Agreement (the "Program") to be known as the AA or AS to BS in Education Pathway with a major in Early Childhood/Late Childhood (K-6, Elementary Education) on the terms and conditions set forth herein;

NOW THEREFORE, based on the mutual promises set forth herein, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto, intending to be legally bound, have agreed as follows:

**ARTICLE 1. CHARACTERISTICS OF PITTSBURG STATE UNIVERSITY/KANSAS  
CITY KANSAS COMMUNITY COLLEGE TRANSFER AGREEMENT**

Basic Purpose. Subject to the terms of this Agreement, students who have completed an Associates of Arts or Science Degree can automatically transfer up to 64 college credits to Pittsburg State University upon submission of official transcripts. Graduates receive a Bachelor of Science in Education with a major in Early Childhood/Late Childhood (K-6, Elementary Education) by successfully completing an additional 60 hours as set forth by the Department of Curriculum and Instruction, in as little as two academic years.

Program.

Expectations of the community college. KANSAS CITY KANSAS COMMUNITY COLLEGE shall offer curriculum leading to the award of an Associate of Arts or Science degree. KANSAS CITY KANSAS COMMUNITY COLLEGE shall be accredited by a regional accrediting agency such as North Central.

Transfer of Courses from an Accredited Community College to Pittsburg State University. Courses meeting general education requirements for the Associate of Arts or Science (AA or AS) degree at KANSAS CITY KANSAS COMMUNITY COLLEGE will transfer to PSU to partially fulfill the general education requirements of the Bachelor of Science (BS) degree in Education with a major in Early Childhood/Late Childhood (K-6, Elementary Education). (Remedial courses offered at the Community College level cannot be applied toward BS Degree Requirements.) Attached and incorporated herein, is the PSU Bachelor of Science (BS) degree in Education with a major in Early Childhood/Late Childhood (K-6, Elementary Education) Program Guide as well as a general education requirement chart with course equivalencies designated for KANSAS CITY KANSAS COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

Bachelor of Science in Education Degree Requirements. In order to be awarded a BS Degree in Education with a major in Early Childhood/Late Childhood (K-6, Elementary Education) from PSU, the student must meet the following degree requirements:
