# ARTICULATION AGREEMENT University of Saint Mary

### And

## Kansas City Kansas Community College May 2014

THIS AGREEMENT, by and between the University of Saint Mary (USM) and Kansas City Kansas Community College (KCKCC) is made to provide students enrolling in the KCKCC Associate of Arts degree in Pre-Sports Management a seamless transfer of college credits into the USM Bachelor of Science degree in Sport Management.

## NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed by and between the parties as follows:

1.) Students who have received an Associate of Arts degree in Pre-Sports Management from KCKCC will be given full credit for the Associate degree to be applied towards the Bachelor of Science degree in Sport Management at USM. KCKCC's Associate of Arts degree in Pre-Sports Management is as follows:

3.) Additionally, for students who have met the KCKCC requirements for the Associates of Arts in Pre-Sport Management and have completed courses equivalent to the USM MKT 231 (Principles of Marketing) and IT 120 (Management Information Systems) would have the ability to receive up to 71 credits toward the USM Bachelors of Science in Sport Management.

- 4.) KCKCC students admitted under the terms of this articulation agreement will be considered in junior level standing (60-89 credits earned), and with the exception of the lower-level Theology requirement, not required to take any other lower-level general education courses as set forth in the USM degree plan above.
- 5.) KCKCC students admitted under the terms of this articulation agreement will be eligible for the various scholarships for transferring students that are currently offered or may be offered in the future provided all requirements of the scholarship are met. These scholarships include, but are not limited to: the Mother Mary Berchmans Award; the

Mother Mary Olive Mead Award; and the Sister Mary Kevin Hollow Award (all renewable annually based on students meeting renewal criteria with awards based on enrollment status, entering GPA, and educational goal). - 6.) USM and KCKCC will actively market and promote this agreement through all appropriate channels that are to include KCKCC's academic advising services and students enrolled in the Associate degree program. Advertising, student newsletters, flyers, email distribution, and class presentations may be utilized by both parties to promote the agreement to interested parties.
- 7.) USM will inform KCKCC of any changes in the requirements for the Bachelor of Science in Sport Management degree.
- 8.) USM will provide aggregated GPA data to KCKCC, upon request, to measure the academic success of KCKCC graduates versus other graduates of the USM Bachelors of Science in Sport management.
- 9.) KCKCC will inform USM of any changes in the KCKCC requirements of the Associate of Arts degree in Pre-Sport Management.
- 10.) This agreement may be revised or discontinued by either party or by mutual agreement.
