



**Articulation Agreement between
Hutchinson Community College
Pharmacy Technician Program
and**

Kansas City Kansas Community College

November 1, 2010

Based upon the mutual interest for the continued growth of students pursuing pharmacy technician courses and in an effort to provide a continuing articulated program that builds on past learning experience and eliminates unnecessary duplication of instruction, we mutually subscribe to the following:

1. **Kansas City Kansas Community College** students who have completed selected general education courses with a minimum grade of a C in each course and an overall grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale (3.0 on a 5.0 scale) and have met the required proficiency levels attached to this articulation agreement will be granted transfer credits in the Pharmacy Technician Program.
2. Challenge exams will be provided for students for HR 105 Medical Terminology following the common practices at Hutchinson Community College.
3. Guidance and support for the Pharmacy Technician Program will begin at **Kansas City Kansas Community College** and will continue at Hutchinson Community College through individual advising sessions.
4. Hutchinson Community College will waive any assessment testing for students transferring in a Basic English and Basic Algebra course with a grade of at least C in these courses.
5. **Kansas City Kansas Community College** is responsible for completing an official transcript for any students transferring into the Pharmacy Technician Program and providing the transcript to Hutchinson Community College at the student's request.
6. The student is responsible for completing the Pharmacy Technician Program Application and requesting official transcripts for the Hutchinson Community College Records Office.
7. Upon receipt of application and transcripts the student will be considered for admission into the Pharmacy Technician Program.

8. All transcripts will be evaluated by the Hutchinson Community College Records Office and the Pharmacy Technician Program.

9. The college course(s) covered by this Pharmacy Technician Program articulation agreement are designed to lead to the Certificate in Pharmacy Technician which will allow the student to sit for the National Pharmacy Technician Certification Exam offered by the Pharmacy Technician Certification Board.

10. This agreement will be in effect upon signing of both parties and is subject to review and renewal in June of each academic year. The on-line curriculum is listed below.
