KCKCC Alumna Nursing Scholarship – Maximum award amount is \$1,000 per semester. Fall and Spring semesters only.

- Must be enrolled in a Nursing program as determined by a KCKCC degree plan
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 required
- Preference given to students with financial need
- Preference given to single or working parents
- Award may be used for education expenses

## **Arthur W. Gibson Mortuary Science Scholarship**

The Gibson Scholarship reimburses Mortuary Science students who successfully pass (on the first attempt) the National Mortuary Science Board Exam. Reimbursement is made directly to the student after verification is received from the KCKCC Mortuary Science Program Coordinator.

Succor Scholarship - Maximum award amount is \$1,500 per semester. Fall and Spring semesters only.

- Must be enrolled in a Nursing, Police Science, Fire Science or TEC program as determined by a KCKCC degree plan
- Must be a current Wyandotte or Leavenworth County resident
- Must be enrolled full-time unless applicant is a working parent or full time employed student (full time credit hours vary by degree program, visit our <u>FAQ page</u> to learn more)
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.2 preferred
- KCKCC Faculty recommendation letter required if GPA is below 3.2 (Incoming students may submit a letter from their employer, minister, or community leader in lieu of a KCKCC Faculty member)
- Award may be used for educational expenses

<u>Tech Diversity Scholarship</u> – Maximum award amount is \$1,000 per semester. Ten (10) scholarships available for Fall and ten (10) scholarships available for Spring semesters.

- Must be enrolled in one of the following technical education programs as determined by a KCKCC degree plan:

- Preference given to students with a diverse background defined as coming from a population under-represented in the technology field including women, ethnic minorities, and those that self-identify as a member of the LGBTQIA+ community
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 required
- Renewable if established criteria are met

<u>The John Wilson Paulsen Memorial Scholarship</u> – Maximum award amount is \$500 per semester. One (1) scholarship for Fall and one (1) scholarship for Spring semesters.

- Must be enrolled in the Addiction Counselor degree program as determined by a KCKCC degree plan
- Preference given to a student who has experienced incarceration and/or in recovery
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 required
- KCKCC Faculty recommendation letter required
- Award may be used for educational expenses

- Preference given to second year nursing students seeking a CNA or LPN certificate as determined by a KCKCC degree plan
- Preference given to Wyandotte or Leavenworth County residents
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 required

- Must be enrolled in a degree or certificate program as determined by a KCKCC degree plan
- Preference given to students in an education program
- Must be a Kansas resident, preference given to Wyandotte County residents
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 required
- Must be enrolled full time (full time credit hours vary by degree program, visit our FAO page to learn more)
- Recipient must be willing to attend and be recognized at the WYCARSP meeting in May
- Award may be used for educational expenses
